# WHAT IS POODLL?

Poodll creates interactive content to build language learning, audio and video recording in Moodle. It can be used as audio/video assignments and quizzes for assessment for learning. It gives students opportunities to practice what they learned.

# POODLL MINI LESSON

What is Poodll Mini Lesson? Language activities are combined into a self-guided lesson. It is comprised of a sequence of lesson items.

THERE ARE 7 LESSON ITEM TYPES:

- 1. **Content page** Adding content in the form of text, video, audio, or image. It is not graded.
- 2. **MultiChoice** Provides a single multiple-choice question.
- 3. **Dictation Chat** Show a series of dictation items one at a time. Each word is entered in a separate text box and shown as correct or incorrect. Students can either check their answers or skip the question.
- 4. **Dictation** Students listen to the audio and type what they hear.
- 5. **Speech Cards** Show a series of audio in the flashcard. Students record what's on the flashcard.
- 6. Listen and Speak The student records a series of audio response items. Each word to be spoken is shown in a separate text box and shown as correct/incorrect. They can listen multiple times.
- 7. MutiChoice Audio Students record the answer to the multichoice audio question.

### POODLL READALOUD

What is Poodll ReadAloud? Reading practice monitoring tool for assessment and progress that provide words per minute and AI grades accuracy scores based on a student's reading of a passage.

# 3 ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Listen: Speaker reads the passage aloud. Students only listen in this activity. (This activity can be removed by disabling the listen mode in the settings. Under general, uncheck the box called "enable listen mode")
- 2. **Practice:** Listen to the speaker and repeat after each sentence to practice. Students will receive instant feedback on pronunciation. (this activity can be removed by disabling the practice mode in the settings. Under general, uncheck the box called "Enable practice mode (listen and repeat))"
- 3. **Read:** Read and record the passage aloud.

# 3. Click Poodll ReadAloud



- 4. Enter the title and reading passage, set the time limit and passage language (the reading passage should not be longer than 3000 characters)
- 5. Click Save and display
- Log in as a test student and click **Read activity** -> press the "**Record**" button and read the passage. When the time limit is reached or finished reading the passage, it will stop, and the audio will be submitted for review.

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### HOW TO GRADE READALOUD?

Automatically graded by AI, then the instructor can listen and regrade them by clicking on the words. Errors are highlighted in red.

- Grading Mode: allows the instructor to toggle word error states
- **Spot Check Mode:** tapping an error word plays back the audio for that word and allows the instructor to spot grade that word
- **Transcript Mode**: tapping an error word shows how the AI transcribed it. Useful for building alternatives for a passage.

# POODLL SOLO

What is Solo? Free speaking activity that grades automatically.

### 4 IMPORTANT STEPS:

- 1. The instructor provides the topic for students to deliver a speech
- 2. Students record themselves speaking
- 3. Students transcribe their own speech
- 4. Students review their recordings based on an automated assessment

- 4. Enter the title and add a speaking topic. Also, you can change the time limit under the speaking targets tab.
- 5. **Setting auto-grading**: under attempts and Auto-grading, tick enable auto-grading checkbox. **Manual grading:** under attempts and auto-grading, tick-off enable auto-grading checkbox
  - a. The rubric can be used to grade the activity
- 6. Click save and display

How to grade the speech? Go to Grades tab -> click Grade under Actions column -> Click Grade entry and choose the mark and leave the feedback -> save changes

Prepare	Students can see the speaking topic, target time, tips, and target words. They can prepare for the speech.
Record	Students should record their speech and try using the target words to get the most marks.
Transcribe	Students can listen to their own speech and type out the transcript.
Review	Students see an automated analysis of their speech.

# WORDCARDS

What is WordCards? Each card contains a set of words/phrases and matching definitions. It is automatically graded.

# LEARNING ACTIVITIES

- Definition check List of new words and definitions are in a card. Each card has a checkbox that the student must check. (When all the cards are checked, the continue button will activate, and the student can proceed to the next step)
- 2. **Practice** Students will practice with a sample of the new words that were introduced in the activity.
  - a. **Choose the Answer:** The student chooses the correct word that matches the definition from the list.
  - b. **Type the Answer:** The student types the word that matches the given definition using the keyboard or selecting letters.
  - c. **Listen and Type:** The student hears the word, and they can either type the word or select letters from the onscreen keyboard.
  - d. Say the Words: The student sees the word and speaks them aloud.
  - e. Listen and Choose: Listen to the word, and the students select the correct answer.

- 4. Enter the title, set the target language and choose the activity type.
- 5. Click Save and display
- 6. Click on the Words Admin tab then click **Add new** button to add the word.



Use the 'Add New' button to add new words for the activity. You can and definition are required.



7. Enter the term (word) and add the definition. You can also select the voice and add audio and images. Then click **save changes.** 

# ADDING VIDEO/AUDIO/SCREEN RECORDER ASSIGNMENT WITH VIDEO/AUDIO FEEDBACK

The students can submit either video/audio/screen recordings.

3. Select Assignment



- 4. Under submission types, tick the 'Cloud Poodll' checkbox
  - a. Choose either audio or video recorder for the type of submission
  - b. Set a time limit for student recordings (the default is 0, which means that there's no limit on the length)
  - c. If transcription is enabled, it provides a transcript of student submission.
  - d. If you want them to **record the screen**, change Cloud Poodll Rec. Skin to "Screen Recorder (video)"

# ADDING A VIDEO/AUDIO QUIZ

1. Click Turn editing on

- 4. Change the settings as a normal quiz then click Save and display
- 5. Click the gear icon then choose Edit quiz



6. Click Add button then choose a new question



7. Select Poodll Recording from the list and click Add



- 8. Enter the question name, text and set the default mark
- 9. Choose the response format (audio/video) then click Save changes

**IMPORTANT!** Please enable the **Safe Save feature** to ensure students' response is uploaded completely. The most common cause of missing students' submissions is that the audio/video was not uploaded completely. It can happen if the student forgets to press the upload button or leaves the page before the recording has finished uploading. Using the 'Safe Save' feature disables the quiz "next" button until the audio/video has been uploaded. (Note: it should only be used when there is one recording question on the page. Please follow the below steps.)

# HOW TO ADD POODLL SUBTILTLE

Poodll subtitle for atto can be used on any video in Moodle. It only works when the video player is selected.

1. Upload the video recording then click on the Atto subtitle icon. (select the link or file with the mouse so that it has a blue selection halo around it)

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2. If the subtitles are already present, it will load on the subtitle editor box. If not, the subtitle area will be empty.

3. Select the in/out times, enter the subtitle text and click green arrow box to apply and click save subtitles.

#### HOW TO ADD TEXT TO SPEECH IN TEXT EDITOR BOX

Please follow the instructions below to add Poodll text-to-speech in any text editor box.

1. Open any activity that has a text editor box then click the '-,+,=' icon



2. Click Text to Audio (Cloud)



3. You can change the speaker to either Male or Female and choose the language. Then click the Insert button.



5. Click Save and display and the text you entered will be turned into audio player.
