POODLL MINI-LESSON

What is it? Poodll MiniLesson is a user-friendly tool for creating interactive language activities in Moodle, covering speaking, listening, reading, and writing with instant feedback.

Why use it? Enhances language instruction through multimedia content, supports diverse learning styles, and provides instant feedback for quick student improvement.

POODLL READ ALOUD

What is it? Poodll Read Aloud allows students to practice reading passages, receive feedback on pronunciation and fluency, and track progress. It supports many other languages than English.

Why use it? Encourages regular practice and improves reading skills through immediate feedback, integrating smoothly into online courses.



POODLL SOLO

What is it? Poodll Solo helps students improve speaking skills through self-recorded monologues, with feedback on fluency, pronunciation, and content.

Why use it? Builds confidence and oral proficiency, integrates seamlessly into online platforms, and supports remote learning.

POODLL WORDCARDS
